Pool Rules

No lifeguards on duty! Swim at your own risk. No smoking or alcoholic beverages within the gated area at any time. Running, rough play, or piggy-backing is not allowed within the gated area. Abusive or profane language is not permitted. Persons under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at least 18 years of age. NO DIVING! Eating or drinking is not allowed in the pool. Glass containers are not allowed anywhere within the gated area. Pets are not allowed inside the gated area. Proper swimwear is required. The OK Health Department mandates that babies and toddlers must wear swim diapers. Please dispose of trash in the trash cans provided.

Architectural Control Committee Reminders

- 1. **Lawns must be mowed and edged** in a timely manner and **flower beds** need to be free of weeds and grass.
- 2. The parking of boats, trailers of any kind, campers, motor homes, and large commercial vehicles is prohibited. If kept in Castlerock, they must be housed or concealed in your garage.
- 3. The **parking of vehicles not driven on a daily basis** is also **prohibited**, and they must be concealed in your garage.
- 4. **Satellite dishes** must be on the backside of your home so that it is not highly visible from the street.
- 5. When replacing the **roof shingles**, make sure they are at least 30-year shingles and are Weatherwood Gray in color. All changes to the current "style" of shingle must be approved by the **ACC**.
- 6. Trim paint must be properly maintained. If you elect to change the **color of your trim**, approval must first be obtained from the ACC.
- 7. One of our key Covenants addresses homeowners making **changes to the outside of their property**. Article VII, par.7.1.1 requires that any room additions, storage buildings, play structures, arbors, etc. must be approved by the ACC before being constructed.
- 8. No **real estate or solicitation signs** are allowed in Castlerock entrances or common areas. Garage sale signs are permitted on the days of the sale and must be promptly removed.
- 9. Questions or approval must be sent in writing to the management company. The ACC Request form is on the Castlerock HOA website; castlerockhomeowners.org. Or homeowners may contact Aria at 405-701-888, homeowners may contact
